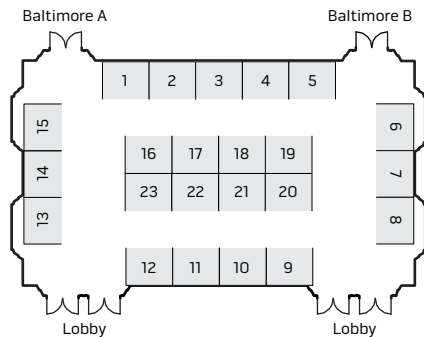
One full exhibit booth includes
